- Requirements: 2.0 GPA and involvement in co-curricular and community service activities

- This is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating seniors with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA who demonstrate excellent in leadership in their communities and academics.

- Financial need is also considered, and two letters of recommendation are required.
