

WHAT IS MUSICAL THEATRE...

Musical Theatre is 7th period every day. M/T/R 2:10–3:00 W/F 2:20–3:00. During class we will work our way through Beauty and the Beast Jr. this fall with shows October 27–29th. Students will learn how to be comfortable on stage, be challenged with choreography, master vocal and projection techniques, character study, blend as an ensemble both musically and functionally.

Signing up...

Any student interested in joining can join the class with the understanding that discipline and participation code must be followed. Failure to follow will result in the student being removed from the class. If students are interested in a speaking or singing role, they will audition Monday and Tuesday August 15-16 between 2:15-3:30. All information is on <u>bereanchristian.org/studentportal</u>

<u>FINE ARTS FEE of \$75</u> will be required for each student that joins musical theatre. This can be paid through myschoolbucks (link on the student portal page) or to the school office. If the student is involved in more that one fine arts production (including Honor Choir), you do not have to pay the fee a second time.

DISCIPLINE AND COMMITMENT CODE...

Theatre is an outside-of-the-box atmosphere. It is even more important that students comply with our code to stay safe and thrive.

Discipline will work on a three strike system.

- 1. After multiple in-class corrections, the student will be brought aside for a conversation about their behavior with the director. A parent or principal may be contacted depending on the severity.
- 2. Student will be written up, removed from class and parent+principal will be contacted.
- 3. Repeated misconduct will result in removal from theatre class.

Commitment to the class includes:

- 1. Students must commit to all rehearsals, dress rehearsals and show dates.
- 2. Checking in every day, on time, 7th period for attendance. Tardies will result in the discipline system being activated.
- 3. Maintaining a professional and positive attitude towards others and self, helping where able, and pursuing a high level of excellence.
